

## 2024 SCHOLARSHIP FORM & QUALIFICATIONS FOR APPLYING

## **Enclosure 1: QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS TO APPLY**

- 1. Applicant must have served or be an immediate family member (defined as spouse, child, or grandchild) of those who served with the US Army VII Corps in Operations Desert Shield/Desert Storm or Provide Comfort or one of the support base activities of those Operations.
- 2. Special consideration will be given to the survivors of VII Corps soldiers who died during Operations Desert Shield/Desert Storm or Provide Comfort.
- 3. No application will be rejected for reason of race, color, national origin, religion, age, sex (gender), physical or mental disability, or sexual orientation.
- 4. Scholarships are limited to students entering or enrolled in accredited technical institutions (trade/specialty degrees), two-year colleges (associate degrees), and four-year universities (bachelor's or graduate degree).
- 5. Applications for full-time and part-time enrollment will be accepted for evaluation.
- 6. Applicants should have graduated from high school or will have an equivalent certificate by June 2024.
- 7. Awards will not be made to individuals receiving military academy appointments or full four-year scholarships. Rank-ordered alternates will be placed in lieu of primary selectees when this situation occurs.
- 8. Successful applicants may apply and qualify for Association scholarships in subsequent years.
- 9. The scholarship award will be paid by check to the school the student attends upon receipt of request from the scholarship winner and proof of admission or registration for Fall 2024 semester courses at an accredited institution, college, or university.
- 10. Print or type the application. Ensure the four-page application form, essay, academic transcripts, and two letters of recommendation are included in one packet. This packet may be submitted **either** electronically or in hard copy.
